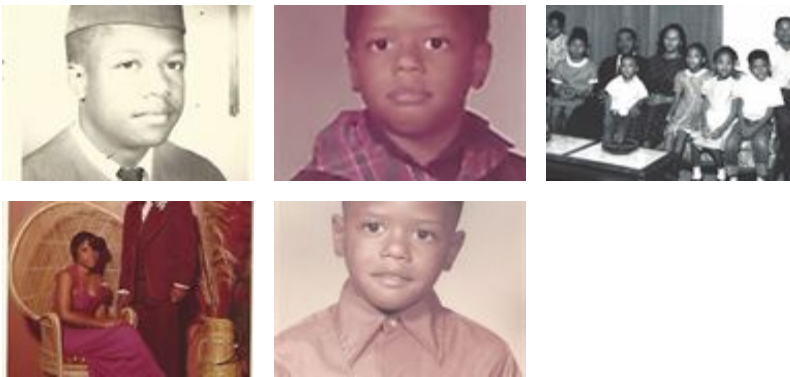
“ To the Hunter family,
