Joseph Anthony Lewis was born the second of four children to Charlie and Martha (Feist) Lewis. He came into the world on December 28, 1956, in Denver, Colorado. He was raised with faith and family values in a very religious Jehovah's Witness household. Joseph attended Washington High School in Los Angeles, California (C/O 1975). At a young age, Joseph had shown that he was very mechanically inclined. He was naturally gifted at troubleshooting/repairing the engines on cars and trucks. After high school, he attended Trade-Tech Institute in Los Angeles, where he enhanced his skills and abilities. As a teenager, he met the love of his life; Sherann Johnson. In the 1980's; Joseph loved driving around Los Angeles with her in his two-tone convertible Coup de Ville. It was a very unique vehicle at the time.

During Joseph's career, he worked for The City of Beverly Hills, the U.S.P.S. and utility companies. He also could guide others to make car repairs over the telephone.

Around 1991; Joseph moved to Beaumont, Texas to assist in the care of his grandmother. Sometime later, he started a career as a long-haul truck driver. He lost communication from his soul mate for over 20 years. In 2019, they were able to reconnect. They were able to travel and see the world. Joseph was extremely happy. Unfortunately, another separation occurred.

Although Joseph stayed on the road for months at a time; he was able to connect with his brothers in Los Angeles and Phoenix. While on the road, he was hit by a truck in the San Antonio area. He was Heli-ported to a hospital and survived. One year ago, he had spinal surgery. He was forced to learn how to walk again. This was a great struggle for a senior who had always lived FREE and independent his entire life. He often spoke of being in great pain.

Joseph's aunt (Johnita Petties) in Beaumont has recently passed away (6/27/23). Joseph may have passed away on the day of her funeral-7/8/23. His body was discovered in his residence ~ 9-days later. (Coincidentally, his mother and aunt's oldest son passed away within a short time of each other ~20-years ago).

Joseph was preceded in death by his parents, Charlie and Martha Lewis and his younger brother Samuel.

He is survived by his brother Charles Lewis (Charlotte Ann) of Phoenix, Arizona. His brother Johnathan (Maria) of Valencia, California. His nieces and nephews: Johnathan Jr, Joshua, Jennifer and Justin of Valencia, CA. His cousins' Matthew and Jason (Tosha) Petties of Beaumont, Texas. His sister Charlene (Lewis) and His soulmate SherAnn Johnson. There are many other friends and relatives who knew and loved Joseph.

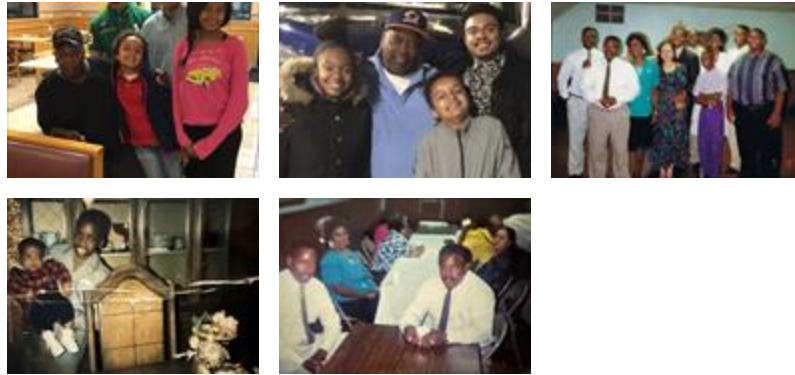
