He was strong-willed, incredibly stubborn but had an enormous heart. When we hear a Harley, ZZ Top's song,

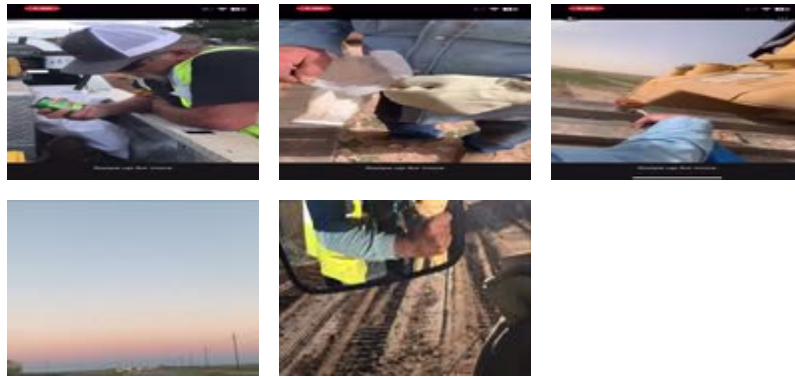
or an inappropriate joke, we will think of Daddy. He will be incredibly missed by everyone who
