



## Mr. Lee Roy Gordon

December 23, 1943 - March 6, 2024

Lee Roy Gordon was born December 23, 1943 in Egypt, Texas to the late Robert and Annie Gordon. He was educated in Texas City, Texas and was a graduate of Booker T. Washington High School. He furthered his education by attending Lee College in Baytown, Texas graduating with an Associate's Degree in Chemical Abuse Counseling.

Lee then went on to serve his country in the United States Army as a communication specialist and a military policeman. He served his country in combat in Vietnam and during his military career he also travelled to Korea, Germany, Panama, and various parts of the world. After 23 years of service, he retired at the rank of Sergeant First Class in 1989.

After his retirement from the military, Lee refused to sit at home and worked for the City of Texas City, and then Harris County Juvenile Probation Department. He retired after another 20 years of working for Harris County.

Lee settled in Texas City with his wife Claudette of 34 years with four children: Tyrosha, Tyrek, Brittani, and Shevonyeh. He loved playing dominoes, fishing, and watching his favorite football team, the Dallas Cowboys.

Religion was an enduring theme in his life and Lee never met a stranger, and he offered a helpful hand to everyone. He accepted Christ as his savior at an

early age and was baptized at Barbour's Chapel in Texas City, Texas and was an active member in the church until his health failed.

On Wednesday, March 6, 2024, Lee answered the Lord's call and completed his work on this side of heaven and entered into eternal rest. He was reunited with his parents, sisters: Barbara "Christine" Carter and Agnes Ricks; and his brothers, Elphonso Matthews and Robert Gordon.

Lee leaves behind an extended family, many friends and his Barbour's Chapel Church family. He survived by his wife of 34 years, Claudette Gordon of Texas City, TX; three daughters: Tyrosha Hopkins (Andrew) of Missouri City, TX, Brittani Thomas (JuMarcus) of La Marque, TX, and Shevonyeh Barker of Texas City, TX; one son, Tyrek Swaby, currently serving in the US Army and stationed at Fort Bliss, TX; one uncle, Joel of Eagle Lake, TX; nieces: Deborah Norris, Pamela Bridges and Brenda Bridges all of Texas City, TX; nephews: Archie (Lisa) Gordon of Dallas, TX and Isiah (Marilyn) Ricks III of League City, TX; and seven grandchildren.

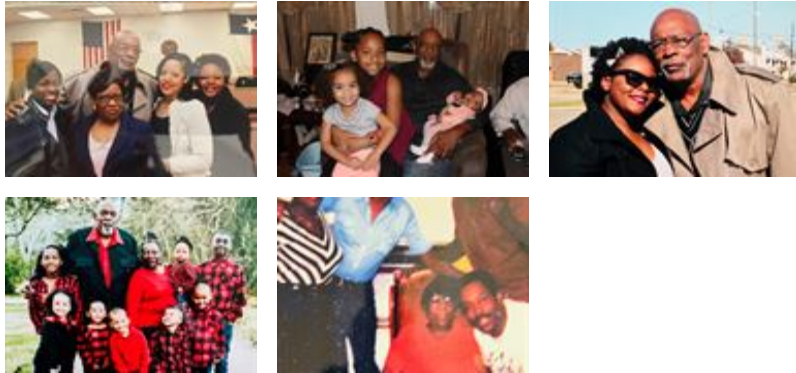

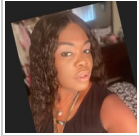
