Mrs. Peaches Griffith Charles, 72, passed away Thursday, May 31, 2018. Mrs. Charles was born July 17, 1945 in Bayou Chicot, Louisiana to the late Horace Griffith and Sadie Skinner Griffith. She accepted Christ at an early age and was baptized by the late Reverend J.B. Wilson of Morning Pilgrim Baptist Church.
