Sharon Rene Allen, 62, was the third of seven children born to the late Lee and Jeweline Allen on December 3, 1960 in Lake Providence, Louisiana. She transitioned from this earthly life to be with the Lord on Sunday, December 4, 2020

Sharon was baptized at Barbour's Chapel Baptist Church at an early age and remained a member until she became ill. She was raised in Texas City, TX and educated in Texas City ISD public schools. In high school, Sharon ran track and graduated with the class of 1979. She attended College of the Mainland in Texas City, TX and Jackson State University in Jackson, Mississippi.

Sharon was the best kept secret of the Allen family. While the other siblings were outgoing and unrestrained, she was quiet and reserved, never in the midst of chaos or bringing attention to herself, therefore, not too many knew she was a part of the family. She preferred being in the background rather than front and center.

Sharon was employed as a surgical technician in the operating room at the University of Texas Medical Branch in Galveston, TX before moving to Warren, Ohio in 1994. There, she was an associate at Walmart and a machine operator at Sajar Plastics and The Marbol Company.

In 2002, she returned home to care for her mother and began her 15 year tenure as a stocker at Walmart in La Marque where she remained employed until her health failed in 2020.

Sharon is preceeded in death by her parents, Lee and Jeweline Allen; brother, Darrell Allen; grandparents, Berry and Ruthie Allen and Louis and Clara Dickerson; niece Ta' Shawn Broussard; and great nephew, Tevin Allen, Jr.
