December 29, 1993 - October 31, 2025

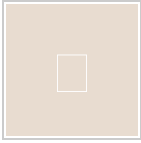
Thomas was born on December 29, 1993 in Amarillo, Texas to Steve and Anita Hegeman

His family and friends will miss him dearly and love him forever.

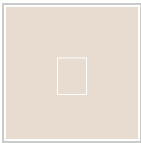
